- 1- Recent posts and announcements are displayed in the Announcements block
- 2- Click on Yas guides to access to all user guide which help you to use Yas E-learning Services.
- 3- The Timeline block provides an overview of deadlines. Deadlines may be sorted by due dates or by dates or course.
- 4- The Calendar block displays the following events.
- 5- The Upcoming events block displays events from the calendar in a summarised list.
- 6- The course overview block enables students to look for their subjects and check their subject progress. By clicking on each subject, you can select your subject
